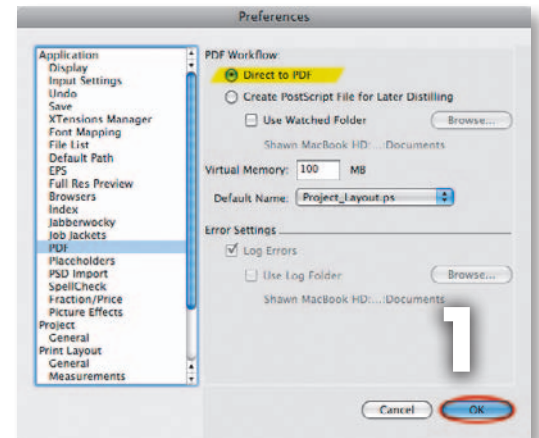


1. Setting Quark Preferences

The PDF export filter built into Quark does not create a clean, reliable PDF all of the time. If available, we recommend that you use Acrobat Distiller to create your PDFs. Use the built in export filter only if you don't have the full version of Adobe Acrobat. To use the built in Quark engine to make PDFs, go into the Preferences under the Quark menu. Click on the PDF tab and select Direct to PDF.



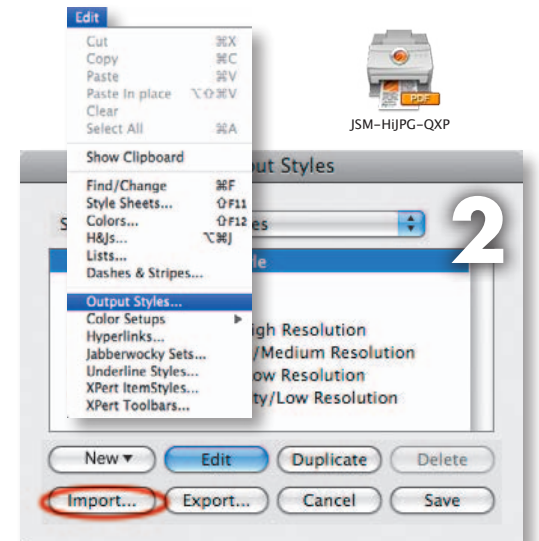
2. Installing the Settings Files

Download the J.S. McCarthy Quark export settings from our website. These are special files designed to allow live transparency, older settings files will not work. The settings file is compressed in the .zip format and will need to be decompressed before using.

To install the correct Quark export styles go into the Edit menu and choose Output Styles. In the Output styles menu click on the Import button and navigate to and pick the JSM HijPG-QXP81 output style you downloaded. This will add a new PDF output style to your export menu.



3. Exporting the PDF file

Open your file and choose "Export ----> Layout as PDF" from the File Menu.

Under the PDF Style Menu choose the JSM-HijPG81 style. Pick a name and location and click the Save button to save your file as a PDF. After your PDF has been saved be sure to open it and check it carefully.
